Egg recipe in time for Easter season

Nesting Scotch eggs


[Ingredients] Serves 2

- A. 4 boiled eggs (10 if using quail eggs)
- B. 1.5 servings of your favorite meat patty*
- C. 1/4 cup flour
- D. Breadcrumbs as required

[Method]

- 1. Wrap (A) with (B).
- 2. Mix (C) with 1/4 cups of water.
- 3. Dip (1) into (2), and coat (D) well.
- 4. Fry (3) until golden brown using 170°C heated oil.
- 5. Please serve with Thousand island dressing (Ketchup + Mayo) or

ketchup sauce (Ketchup + Worcestershire sauce) or any of your favorite sauces!



- (1) Mix together 1 egg, 2 heaped TBS breadcrumbs, salt & pepper, nutmeg and sprinkle of cooking sake (sweet sherry liquor is ok).
- (2) Mix minced beef (roughly size of a child's hand) and pork mince (1/2 size of a child's hand).
- (3) Finally mix in finely chopped 1/4 onion (cooked onions are even better).

Mixing in chopped cabbages or celery leaves adds extra flavors too.



Serve the scotch eggs on a bed of thinly sliced cabbage for nesting effect.
